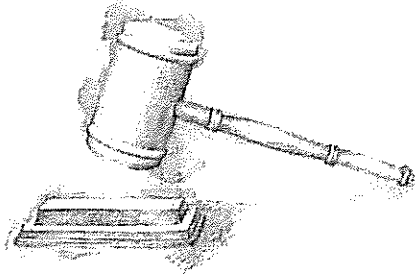


MEDINA COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION LAW DAY 2011 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

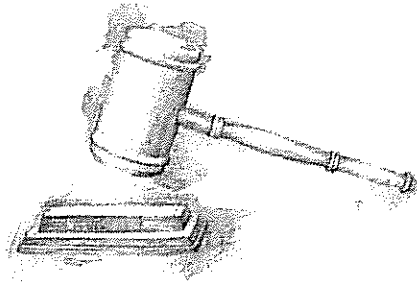
"The Legacy of John Adams". John Adams became the nation's first lawyer-president in 1797. As a lawyer, Mr. Adams was well known for respecting the rule of law and the rights of the accused. He was no stranger to taking on unpopular clients or cases, specifically when he represented British soldiers accused of firing into a crowd of civilians in the so called "Boston Massacre." Discuss one or more of his achievements and how his examples can be applied by modern legal professionals.

RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. The essay must be approximately, but not longer than, three pages, typewritten and double spaced. It shall be accompanied by a completed Scholarship Application. The student's name shall not be affixed to the essay, but the scholarship application (with student's name) should be stapled to the essay. The essay and application are to be received by the Medina County Bar Association, 93 Public Square, Medina, Ohio 44256 by 4:00 p.m., April 15, 2011. 2. All essays and applications will become the property of the Medina County Bar Association, which reserves the right to publish and distribute the winning essay to its members and others. Essays and related application material will not be returned to applicants. No plagiarism shall be allowed.
3. Each applicant must reside in Medina County, Ohio but does not need to attend a high school located in Medina County.
4. One winner will be selected from all entries. That winner will receive a one time only cash award of \$2,500.00, paid directly to the college, university or other post-secondary educational institution he or she will attend in the fall of 2011.
5. The winner will also be invited to be a guest at the Medina County Law Day luncheon on May 13, 2011.
